Art Knowledge Organiser

Key Vocabulary	
Composition	Putting different elements together in a pleasing way.
Hue	Describing an exact colour: sky blue, dark green, rose pink.
Proportion	How big a part of something looks compared to the rest of it.
Shade	Adding black to a colour makes a shade.
Shadow	A dark area created when light is blocked.
Still life	An artwork showing a collection of things that don't move, e.g. objects rather than people.
Tint	Adding white to a colour makes a tint.
Tone	How light or dark a colour is.

Colour Mixing


Making colours lighter:

+ a lighter colour
+ water
+ white

Making colours darker:

+ a darker colour
+ black

Using tints and shades can help a painted object appear three-dimensional.
